Resourcing girls and young feminists—and the ecosystems they need to transform the world.

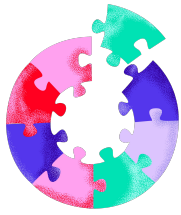

The Dream & Power Fund responds to this gap by resourcing the power, leadership, and imagination of girls and young feminists. We invest in the organisations they lead and rely on, while also resourcing the wider ecosystems, relationships, knowledge, narratives, care, and shared infrastructure that allow movements to flourish.

Our ambition is to help create the conditions in which girls and young feminists can build power, shape movements, challenge dominant narratives, and transform the systems affecting their lives.

HOW WE INVEST



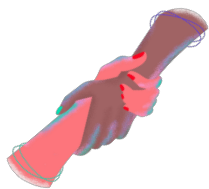
LOCALLY ROOTED. GLOBALLY CONNECTED.

We resource community-rooted organizations working directly with girls and young feminists while strengthening connections across movements, issues, and geographies.



FLEXIBLE + LONG-TERM.

Partners determine what they need to sustain their work and respond to changing realities. Our ambition is to build toward partnerships of up to ten years.



SHARED POWER + RESOURCES.

Partners help shape priorities, guide learning, and influence how the Fund evolves, while collectively stewarding resources for shared priorities, collaboration, and emerging opportunities.



CARE, SAFETY + PROTECTION.

We invest in the conditions that allow girls, young feminists, and movements to participate, lead, take risks, and sustain their work.

TWO INTERCONNECTED INVESTMENTS

Transformative change requires both the collective capacity to build power and the narrative power to expand what is possible. We invest in both.

ECOSYSTEM INFRASTRUCTURE

Flexible, long-term funding supports locally rooted organizations working directly with girls and young feminists while strengthening the relationships, collective leadership, solidarity, care, shared strategy, and connections across movements that enable collective power and lasting change.

NARRATIVE POWER

Flexible funding supports girls' and young feminist organizations, artists, storytellers, researchers, and cultural workers to experiment with ideas, stories, art, research, media, and cultural strategies that challenge dominant narratives, expand political imagination, and shift what societies believe is possible.



WHY THIS MATTERS



Girls have a right to freedom and flourishing. Every girl has the right to live free from violence and discrimination, exercise her rights, and shape her own future.

Girls and young feminists are also powerful agents of transformative change. Across movements and regions, they organize where institutions have failed, build relationships across generations and issues, defend human rights, reshape narratives, and imagine and build alternatives.

Yet philanthropy has not kept pace. Girls comprise nearly one-fifth of the world's population yet receive less than 1% of global development assistance. Only 1.9% of U.S. charitable giving supports women and girls, with even less intentionally reaching girl- and youth-led organizing.

Strong organizations need strong ecosystems. Relationships, trusted networks, shared knowledge, narrative power, care, and flexible resources help organizations collaborate, adapt, and sustain change over time. Investing in this infrastructure allows knowledge and strategies to travel, deepens collaboration, and strengthens the collective capacity movements need to create lasting change.
